Psychology Decides 2025, AHPCZ Council Representative. DAY 2 January 8 2025 (Morning Update 10hrs 23mins)

As Society of Zambezi Psychology, we will give daily updates of Allied Health Practitioners Council of Zimbabwe representative of Psychology, **Online Votes**. We will give comments and Analysis to aid on the fairness and freeness of the electoral process.

1. **Mr Shanyurai** remains the most sophisticated candidate going for day two **without a single vote** to his account on the online platform, the most difficult question is that where is his vote? We still have however 5 more days.
2. **Dr Mutambara's** votes are now at **17** votes, its still sitting on the **same votes number** as of yesterday at 21hrs 55mins and 22hrs 29 mins (January 7, 2025). Her votes still remain at 17 on this 8th of January 2025 at 10hrs: 23 mins. She is trailing the leading candidate by **40 votes**.
3. **Prof Zirima** is leading the psychological race and has **57 votes**. Yesterday 7th January by 22hrs 29mins he had 51 votes, from yesterday to date (8th January, 2025), he has received 6 more votes. He is the only candidate who has received votes from yesterday 21hrs 55mins (January 7, 2025) to this 8th of January 2025 at 10hrs: 23 mins.
4. We still have **5 more days of voting** and every candidate can be hopeful to grab the scudo.
5. A general observation is that **voters for Prof Zirima are more determined** in what they want from the start and this is seen by the early morning, day and night votes, while Dr Mutambara has received her votes mostly during the day.
6. What ever the result of the election will be at the end of the voting process Prof Zirima has proved that he **has a strong constituency** within the registered psychology fraternity.
